Transformation of Railway Dock into a Bicycle and Pedestrian Friendly Quay Location: Railway dock, Leeuwarden

Spoordok is a dynamic area in Leeuwarden where a diverse community comes together, including emergency seekers, status holders and refugee Ukrainians. The area is currently functionally designed, but it lacks a strong connection with the rest of the city. The aim of this project is to integrate Spoordok into the urban fabric of Leeuwarden, with an emphasis on placemaking. By transforming the area, we want to prevent Spoordok from becoming an isolated enclave and instead make it a vibrant part of the city.



This project aims to transform Spoordok into an attractive and accessible space for cyclists and pedestrians, realized in close collaboration with the residents and users of the area. The active participation of the community is important to ensure that the transformation meets their wishes and needs. This involvement contributes to the connection with the urban network of Leeuwarden, so that the location is not only used temporarily, but is permanently included in the cityscape. We focus on creating an environment that improves the quality of life and well-being of residents in both the short and medium term.
